After reading this interesting book I want you to write up a short paper explaining your view on one of the issues raised in the book. Pick one of those issues and using your own experience as well as the arguments in the book to explain your beliefs.

Maybe it will be helpful for you to focus your assignment as an answer to this question:

Are emojis a form of language, how so or how not so?

Your write up should be approximately 1,500 words (A4, 1.5 spaced) and follow APA format regarding any quotes or citations. Citations and quotes from outside sources are not necessary for this paper but are always welcome if you want to take it further. There have been many scholarly papers written on this topic of late so you will not have trouble finding outside sources if that is the way you want to take this.
